


#### **Club Tournaments**

# Obituary The Passing of an Era

Lena Chandler of Greenwood Osterley Archers and Middlesex County Archery Association sadly passed away on 7th November 2015 aged 91.

Lena Along with her late Husband Stan Chandler (Passed away April 2014) were members of the greenwood Court Branch of the independent order of foresters and in the late 1950s were the two founder members of Greenwood Archery club which later became Greenwood Osterley Archers in 1985.

Lena dedicated her life to the sport of archery both as an archer developing new and upcoming archers of all ages and as a competitor achieving many awards including with her husband Stan a total of 27 Laleham Archery Club Albion Medals Between them, Covering the 38 Years of their attendance at the annual tournament. As well as being a successful archer, Lena was an award winning oars woman competing at national level.

Her Continuous work within the Middlesex County set a standard of shooting which is maintained by GOA Club members today.

Lena was a member of the Royal Toxophilite Society.

Apart from Shooting Lena used to encourage new members and help them feel welcome to the club. She would always make sure people had tea and biscuits during the morning when people were having a quick break from shooting. She always welcomed people with a smile.

Past and present members of Greenwood Osterley Archers will fondly remember Lena.

The Passing of Lena and her beloved Husband Stan is the End of an Era in the sport of archery, which only occurs one in a generation.

Family and friends of Lena and Stan will miss both of them for their kind and gentle natures. Lena and Stan have been apart of Meera and Kishan's lives since they were born. The Loss of Lena came to them as a shock. They were like her grandchildren.

We are thankful to have been a part of their lives. We will always remember her smile and her brilliant tips for good shooting!

Apart from being a true archer Lena was a humble soul that touched the lives of many.
